- Being adequately insured, to include Third Party & Public Liability
- Complying with all Road Traffic Legislation

Conditions

1. **All exhibits must be booked in on arrival.**
2. The person in charge of the exhibit must report to the commentary caravan, located by the entrance to the ring, and book in and collect an exhibit number which must be displayed in a visible position on the exhibit.
3. You must drive and move all mobile powered exhibits with care and consideration for people on the Rally Field.
4. You must abide by Road Traffic Regulations.
5. Exhibits must be on site by 10am and must not leave before 5pm both days.

Safety

Legislation recognises that the Rally field is a public highway. Therefore drivers have an obligation in law to abide by Road Traffic Regulations.

In particular :-

1. Only one person, the driver, may be on a moving tractor, this includes tractors which may have been built with a double seat, such as early David Browns. The only exception is tractors with a safety cab that are adapted to carry more than one person.
2. All unsupervised drivers must be 16 years old or over and must hold an appropriate driving licence.
3. All drivers, between 13 years and 16 years, must be supervised in an area with no public access, and must be named on insurance.

A Skip for Rubbish and an Elsan Waste Point will be provided on site.
